FER REMISSION

If you are in receipt of Job Seekers Allowance (JSA), Employment Seekers Allowance (ESA), or currently unemployed, actively seeking work and in receipt of benefits you may be eligible for fee remission (does not apply to all courses). You must bring along evidence of receipt of one of the benefits listed below with you when you come in to enrol. This evidence must be current and dated within 3 months of the start of the course.

Benefits to support fee remission - JSA. ESA, Income Support/Universal Credit, Housing Benefit, Council Tax Reduction Benefit, Pension Guarantee Benefit. Fee remission may also be based upon the highest level of previous qualifications achieved. Please check your eligibility with our Admissions Team.

INSTALMENTS

If you are signing up for an adult learning course you are able to pay in instalments. A maximum of 3 equal instalments are to be paid in the 1st term at the start of the course, or within the first 50% of a course lasting less than 1 year.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

ADVANCED LEARNER LOAN

To help learners aged 19 and over to cover the cost of course fees of a level 3. 4, 5 and 6 college or training course.

Loan eligibility does not depend on your income and there are no credit checks. Repayments don't start until the April after your course has finished and you don't have to pay anything back unless you earn more than £25,000 a year. Bursaries are available for those on a low income

To support your application for an Advanced Learner Loan you will require a letter from the college. Please contact admissions for more information.

DISCRETIONARY LEARNER SUPPORT FUND

This fund helps students from low income families with expenses incurred when studying. You must be aged 19 and over and studying a course below a level 3. The amount received depends on your circumstances. The money can help pay for things like: accommodation, travel, course materials, equipment or childcare.

HEFCE ACCESS TO LEARNING FUND (ALF)

The Government provides Higher Education institutions with ALF to provide discretionary financial help for both full and part-time undergraduate and postgraduate students.

LOW INCOME FUNDING
