In order to access the content:

- You will need to have a google account, if you have one already with your school you will be able to use this, if not then go to www.accounts.google.com and you will be able to create your own account.
- Once you have an account go to www.classroom.google.com and use your account to sign in.
- If it's your first time using Google Classroom, select your Google account when prompted, click the blue **CONTINUE** button, and then follow the on-screen instructions to proceed.
- Click the "+" symbol in the top right of the screen and select join new class and enter the relevant code on the next page for the class you want to join. Please feel free to join more than one class if you are unsure of the area you want to study.
- Navigate to the 'classwork' tab at the top of the class page, here you should find that work has been broken into set weeks for you to complete. If you have any problems please feel free to post on the class 'stream' or email one of the teachers, email addresses can be found in the contact details document at the top of the classwork page.
- Before you start your work I would ask that you complete the 'about you' form located at the top of the 'classwork' page, this will allow us to keep track of all the users.
