



## Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning

This course provides an ideal first qualification for those who are working or want to work as a teaching assistant in a school. You will attend college for one morning each week for a taught session led by one of the tutor team, as well as gaining practical, work-based experience.

### What will I study?

The course is comprised of a number of short units of learning on topics such as child and young people's development, supporting learning activities, supporting children and young people's behaviour and equality, diversity and inclusion in working with children and young people.


There are no examinations. Instead you will gradually develop a portfolio of evidence of your knowledge and skills, including short written tasks, observations in the school and professional discussions.

### Entry requirements

You should be working or volunteering in a school for a minimum of 6 hours per week while you are on the course. It is also important that the school is supportive of your studies and if possible you should have a mentor in your workplace. You do not have to have GCSEs but may be asked to sit a written assessment to check this is the right level course for you.

### Progression

Successful completion of the Level 2 Certificate allows for progression to the Level 3 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning, subject to references.
