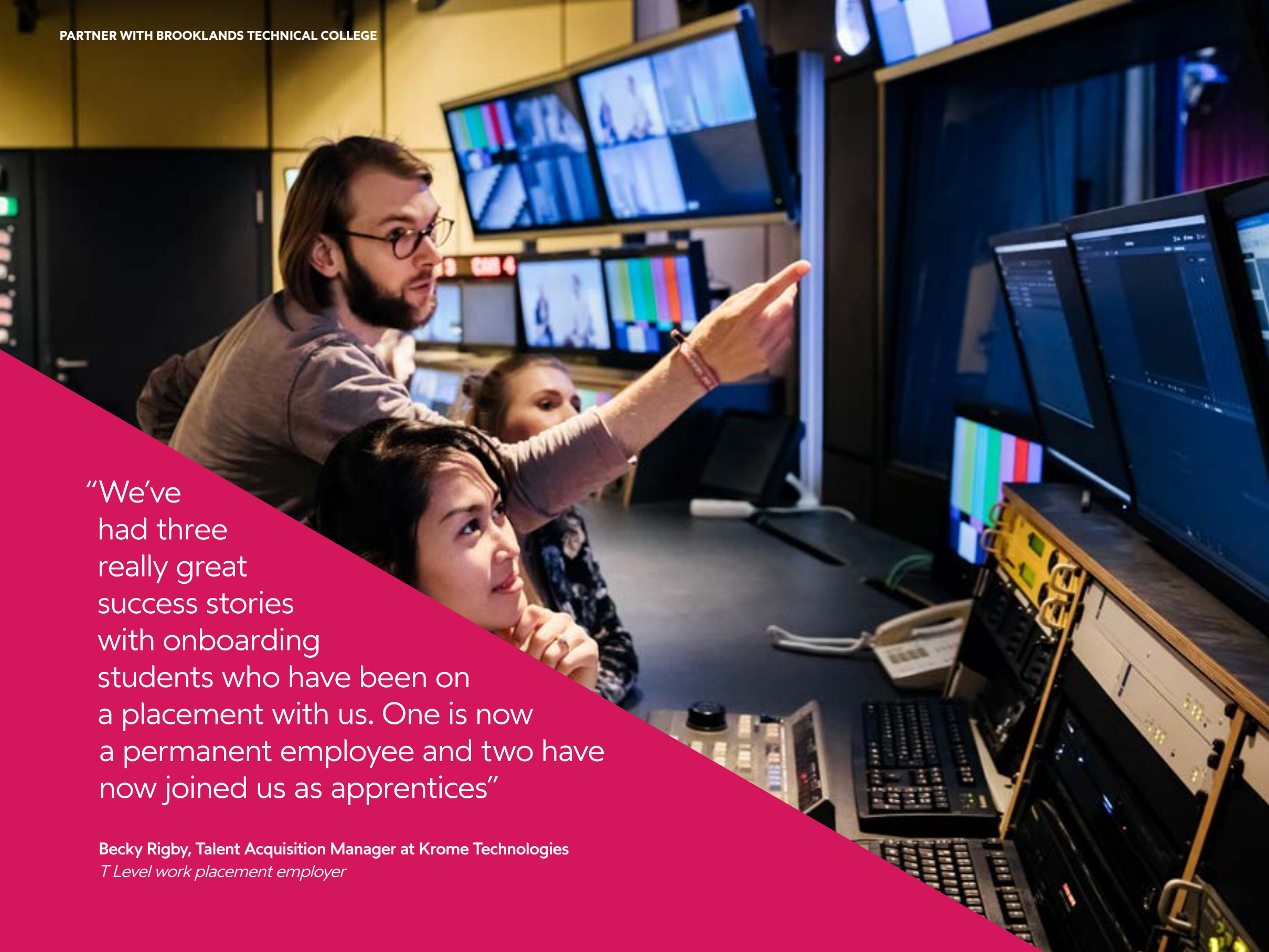

OUR PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMMES

APPRENTICESHIPS

What it is: A job with a contract of employment which combines hands-on work and classroom learning. An apprentice spends 80% of their time working with you and 20% on off-the-job training with us.

Duration: Varies from 1 to 4 years, depending on the level and sector.

Benefits to you: Fill skills gaps, grow your own talent and access government funding to support training costs. Our dedicated team will support you throughout the recruitment and training process.

T LEVEL INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS

What it is: A mandatory component of the T Level qualification – a two-year qualification equivalent to 3 A Levels designed to meet industry needs. It's a substantial, 45-day industry placement for our T Level students.

Duration: Typically arranged as one day a week over a few months, or in a block, to suit your business needs.

Benefits to you: Get a detailed look at a potential future employee, benefit from their skills and enthusiasm on a specific project and contribute to the development of a student in your sector.

WORK EXPERIENCE

What it is: A shorter, structured placement for our 16-18 full-time students. It provides them with a taster of the workplace and the skills required for a particular job.

Duration: Typically 1 - 2 weeks.

Benefits to you: Give back to the community, identify potential future apprentices or employees and provide valuable work exposure to a young person.

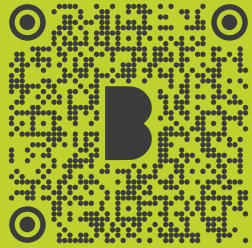
